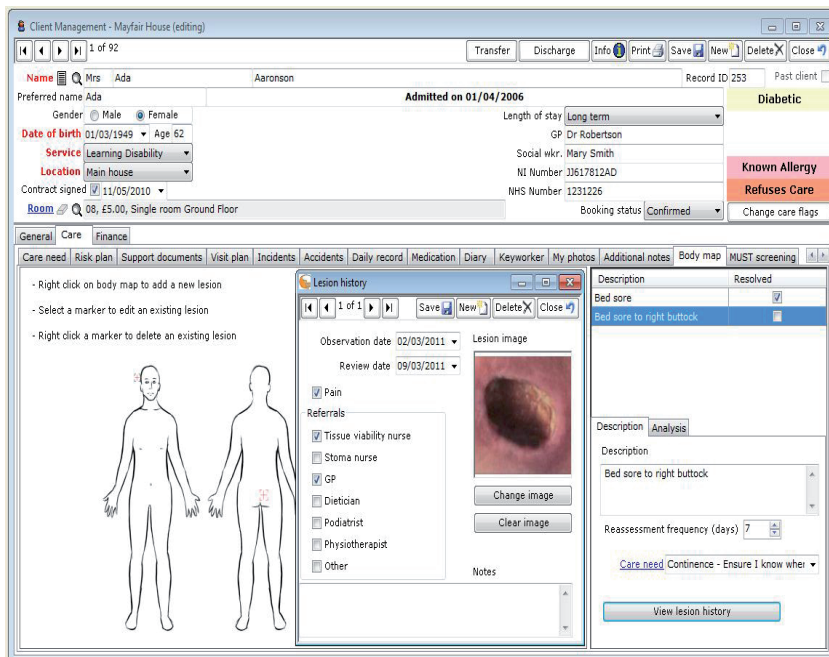

### Assessment of needs

Commonly broken into activities of daily living, the assessment of needs can be used to automatically create the core of a care plan – but a key feature in the CareSys Assessment of needs is that this is not only personalised for the individual, the templates themselves are totally customisable to meet the precise needs of the organisation. The assessment process can be used to create as much information for the care plan as needed, or alternatively the care plan can be created without use of an assessment.



The care plan is a document made up of a number of different elements, including the care needs, risk plans, medication, key workers and personal information such as memory jogging photos and allergies. The elements of the care plan have life cycles with a care need having a defined authorisation process and review cycle and this is all managed simply and effectively in CareSys to ensure that the care plan is constantly up to date. As care is delivered there are a number of tools available, including the MUST tool, body map for wounds and other lesions, diary for visitors, accident tracking, and health measurements.
